

Consent to Processing of Personal Data of an Organiser, Organiser Representative or Contact Person

1. Separate Consent

1.1. This consent is a separate statement by an Organiser, organiser representative, organisation officer, event contact person or other person using Organiser functionality.

2. Personal Data Covered and Purposes

2.1. The following personal data may be processed: name and contact details, role, title or authority to act for the Organiser, organisation name, address, registration number, tax/VAT data and payment details where applicable, history of competitions created or administered, invoices, receipts, reports, payment metadata, communications with the Platform Operator, WIDA, Users, Teachers and Participants, account technical data, Platform actions, consent and audit records.

2.2. The data may be processed for creating and maintaining an Organiser account, verifying and administering the Organiser role, creating, publishing and administering competition pages, providing competition-specific Participant data to the Organiser, reporting to or communicating with WIDA where relevant, issuing invoices, receipts and reports, support, complaints, disputes, security, audit, and legal, accounting, tax or regulatory compliance.

3. Confirmation of Participant Data Rules

3.1. The person giving this consent confirms that they have read the Terms of Service for Competition Organisers, the Privacy Policy and the rules for handling participant personal data.

3.2. The Organiser must use participant data only for the relevant competition and must protect it from unauthorised access, disclosure, copying, loss or misuse.

4. Duration and Withdrawal

4.1. This consent remains valid until the purposes are achieved, retention periods expire, or consent is withdrawn.
