

Consent to Processing of Personal Data of a Teacher

1. Separate Consent

1.1. This consent is a separate statement by a Teacher, school owner, school administrator or person applying for Teacher functionality on the Platform.

2. Personal Data Covered and Purposes

2.1. The following personal data may be processed: name, email address, phone number, school name and address, qualification, teaching experience, role, professional biography if voluntarily provided, Students registered or managed by the Teacher, registration history, payment metadata where the Teacher pays on behalf of Students or Legal Representatives, account technical data, Platform actions, consent and authority records.

2.2. The data may be processed for creating and maintaining a Teacher account, verifying and administering the Teacher role, maintaining school and Teacher profiles, registering Students where required consent or authority has been obtained, interacting with Students, Legal Representatives, Organisers, WIDA and the Platform Operator, transferring Student and Teacher data to WIDA where necessary for WIDA-related purposes, issuing invoices and confirmations, support, complaints, disputes, security and audit.

3. Student Consents

3.1. The Teacher confirms that before entering Student data into the Platform the Teacher obtains consent or authority from the adult Student or the Legal Representative of a minor Student.

3.2. That consent or authority must include registration, processing by the Platform Operator, transfer to the Organiser, transfer to and processing by WIDA, competition administration, results handling and publication of results where required.

3.3. The Teacher must retain evidence of such consent or authority and provide it on reasonable request.

4. Duration and Withdrawal

4.1. This consent remains valid until the purposes are achieved, retention periods expire, or consent is withdrawn.

4.2. Consent may be withdrawn by contacting support@yafers.org. Withdrawal does not affect prior lawful processing and does not prevent processing that continues on another lawful basis.
